GUIDE TO HELPING / GETTING GREAT DONATIONS

The Anderson Annual Auction is coming up on Saturday, March 28, 2026. Funds raised at the auction contribute to classroom assistants, arts programming, technology, sports, and other enrichment programs that directly benefit every Anderson student. This is the school's biggest fundraising event of the year, and its success relies upon the support of our full community.

1. Procure Auction Items – it's as easy as asking!

We are hoping every Anderson family will help procure auction items. Below are details on how to get going, and here is a [template letter](#) to aid your efforts. Whether it's a gift from a business you frequent, a service you can provide, a special experience from your network, or a stay at a family vacation home all make a huge difference!

GUIDE TO GETTING GREAT DONATIONS

GETTING STARTED

1. Make a List

Begin with the people and places you already know. Make a list of PEOPLE - friends, family, coworkers – and think about who has a great connection, cool job, vacation home, or access to something unique. Make a list of PLACES -- Where your child takes/has taken classes or attended camp, and don't forget your favorite restaurant, bakery, boutique, salon, gym, etc...

2. Brainstorm about what a great donation could be and suggest it when you ask.

High value items include: Vacation Home Stays/Weekends, Restaurant or Culinary Experiences, Tickets (Sports, Theater, Concert), Kids' classes or Camp weeks, Unique Access or Behind the Scenes Access, Professional Services, Potential grade-wide Experiences (would your scientist friend volunteer to do an in-class grade-appropriate activity for a period?). More ideas are below.

3. Just do it! Make the conversation part of your regular interaction with the person or business.

4. Be Clear and Reassuring. Donors can set all terms, including blackout dates, expiration dates, guest limits, and location constraints.

5. Share Why It Matters. Parents of P.S. 334, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit. Donations are tax-deductible. Funds support programs not covered by the DOE budget. The auction supports valuable programs including:

- Foreign language instruction
- Assistant teachers who support classrooms of 30+ students
- Chess and instrumental music
- Classroom technology
- Field trips and experiential learning
- Middle school sports programs

6. Emphasize the Benefits and Highlight Visibility. Donors are recognized across emails, our online catalog, event materials, and the auction website, and Anderson families love to patronize businesses that support our school.

7. Think Beyond NYC. Our online auction reaches bidders nationwide.

8. Please Avoid Purchasing Gift Cards. Please do not purchase gift card with cash, there is a risk they sell below face value—direct donations are more impactful.

MORE DONATION IDEAS

- Travel & Getaways — vacation home weekends/weeks, hotel certificates, airline tickets/miles, boat outings, regional trips, passes to local attractions/theme parks
- Unique Experiences — behind-the-scenes tours, meet-and-greets, shadow-a-professional experiences, VIP access, private lessons, stargazing or science experiences.
- Sports & Entertainment — premium seats, memorabilia, lessons, concert/Broadway tickets, movie passes
- Dining & Culinary — chef's tables, tasting menus, cooking/mixology classes, subscriptions, host-a-party packages.
- Kids & Family — camps, party packages, classes, lessons, ski/skating passes
- Health, Wellness & Beauty — spa services, salon services, fitness packages or memberships
- Professional & Home Services — photography, interior design, organizing, tax prep, handyman, tech services.
